

## Bonus Sock Book Mark

Mini Sock loom set up to knit on 12 pegs in the round.

Small amount of Sock yarn

Make 2.

Cast on to 6 pegs using waste yarn and knit 1 row, cut waste yarn.

Attach your main yarn to peg # 1 wrap and knit 1 row. Knit 1 more row, place a stitch marker on the first and last stitch. Your working yarn should be at stitch #1.

Here you will begin knitting the toe I have worked this as stitch 1 is on the right and stitch 6 is on the left.

Decrease Rows	Knit	Skip Stitch	Wrap Stitch
Row 1	4	5	6
Row 2	3	2	1

Row 3	2	4	5
Row 4	1	3	2
Increase Rows	knit	Knit Wrapped Stitch	
Row 1	2	5	
Row 2	2	2	
Row 3	3	6	
Row 4	4	1	

Now we need to place the stitches on the waste yarn on the other 6 pegs. Place the stitches with the markers on first and then do the center ones.

At this point you will begin working in the round.

Foot: Knit 4 Rows

Heel: Repeat the table for the toe.

Leg: Knit 6 rows

Ribbing: Knit 1, Purl 1 for 4 rows

Bind off using the sewn bind off method.

Weave in tails and remove waste yarn. Take 3 pieces of yarn about 20 inches long and braid together. Attach one end at each top center back.
